

Natural Resources Wales position on local transport issues

- Natural Resources Wales had previously expressed concern regarding a lack of a joined up approach between the applicants, to proposed modifications to the minor road running from the junction with the A483 to the site entrances of the proposed Llandinam Repowering & Extension and Llaithddu Windfarms.
- Specifically, it has not been made clear by the two applicants proposing to use this route (CeltPower, and Fferm Wynt Llaithddu Cyf), that they would share usage of the proposed modifications in the form of road improvements and lay-bys, thereby minimising any environmental impacts.
- Following discussion with Powys County Council, we understand that negotiations between the applicants and the Council are ongoing on this issue, and that it is likely to be dealt with by the Council during the Inquiry. We are happy to leave this issue entirely with them.
- We can therefore confirm that Natural Resources Wales does not have any significant issues that it wishes to raise in relation to this topic.
