**MID-WALES WIND FARM INQUIRY
LLANDINAM WIND FARM**

In order to address concerns raised by other parties to the Inquiry, CeltPower Ltd has decided to delete five turbines from the proposed Llandinam windfarm. These turbines are numbered 21, 20, 19, 25 and 26 in the planning application documents. I have enclosed (a) a plan of the development as previously proposed and (b) a plan of the development as it is proposed to be amended. Celtpower is not proposing to change the location of any other turbines, so their coordinates remain as shown in the previous plan.

CeltPower Ltd. will in the course of March submit to DECC supplementary environmental information assessing the impacts of the wind farm subject to this amendment and certain other matters raised by parties to the inquiry. It will provide this information to you when it becomes available.
