Dear Mr Pridham

Carnedd Wen Wind Farm. Section 36 Electricity Act 1989

On 11 December 2008 RWE Npower Renewables Limited applied under Section 36 Electricity Act 1989 for consent to construct and operate a wind farm at Carnedd Wen with a maximum installed capacity of 250MW and for a Direction under Section 90(2) Town and Country Planning Act 1990 that planning permission be deemed to be granted for the development.

Our clients would now like to amend the terms of the Section 36 Application so as to specify a maximum installed capacity of 150 MW. Although there have been changes to the physical content of the scheme since the submission of the application those changes are not relevant to this letter which solely concerns the proposed maximum installed capacity of the development.

Therefore we should be grateful if you would confirm that the project description be amended to read as follows:

“The construction and operation of a wind turbine generating station at Carnedd Wen in Powys, Wales, with a maximum installed capacity of 150 MW.”
