**Mid-Wales Conjoined Inquiries
Our Client: Vattenfall Wind Power Ltd**

Further to discussions on the scope and division of matters to be covered under local transport in Session 1 and alternatively under strategic transport in Session 4, you have advised that the Inspector would address this at the Opening Session.

As however preparations for the SEI and evidence relating to Session 1 are underway prior to the Opening Session, we can confirm that we will be progressing on the basis set out below:

- Session 1: our Client will present evidence on local access to the Site (where this falls outside of matters described below for Session 4);
- Session 4: our Client will present evidence on the transport route from Ellesmere Port to SSA C comprising those sections of the sTMP relevant to the Llanbadarn Fynydd site and any alternative routes proposed. Evidence will also be presented on the legal control mechanism addressing the potential cumulative impacts of the transportation of wind turbine components as abnormal loads to the proposed wind farms;
- Inquiry documents: our Client will be preparing associated SEI and evidence for each of the above matters in line with the allocated deadlines for Sessions 1 and 4 respectively.
