### The Electricity Act 1989, The Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) & The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (as amended).

Further to the application by Vattenfall (the applicant) for consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a 17 turbine wind farm and associated works at Llanbadarn Fynydd and deemed planning permission under section 90(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) dated 31 November 2007.

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 14A of The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (as amended) that the applicant submitted additional information (as an addendum to its Supplementary Environmental Information of December 2013) to the Programme Officer for the Inquiry, on behalf of the Secretary of State, on 25 February 2014 to supplement the Environmental Statement dated November 2007 previously submitted in relation to the application.

The applicant has provided a copy of the additional information to Powys County Council on behalf of the Secretary of State. Powys County Council is required to place the additional information on its register under section 69 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

A copy of the additional information has been made available to Powys County Council for public inspection during normal working hours at: Powys County Council, The Gwalia, Ithon Road, Llandrindod Wells, Powys LD1 6AA. The details set out in the two paragraphs above will also apply in respect of any additional information which is received by the Secretary of State relating to the application after publication of this notice.

The application is the subject of a Public Inquiry which commenced on 4 June 2013. Representations about the additional information should be sent in writing to the Programme Officer for the Inquiry, who will forward them to the appointed Inspector, acting on behalf of the Secretary of State. The representations should therefore be sent to: The Inspector, c/o Mr C Banks / Mrs C Jones-Hughes, Programme Officer, Banks Solutions, 21 Glendale Close, Horsham, West Sussex RH12 4GR. Representations should be made no later than 28 March 2014. Unless otherwise indicated, copies of any representations received will be regarded as public documents.

The application also seeks permission to undertake improvement works to land which lies along the proposed transport route to the Site, some of which falls outside the boundaries of the public highway. Notice is given that following recent consultation with Welsh Government, amendments to the application to facilitate access to the Site south of Newtown are proposed.

The amended red line application plans have been deposited at Powys County Council's offices at The Gwalia, Ithon Road, Llandrindod Wells, Powys LD1 6AA and known landowners along the route have been notified by letter. Members of the public may inspect copies of the plans at the Gwalia or online at <http://www.vattenfall.co.uk/en/sei-llanbadarn-fynydd-wind-farm.htm>. Information for owners and tenants drawn from the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (Wales) Order 2012:

"Owner" means a person having a freehold interest or a leasehold interest the unexpired term of which is not less than seven years, or, in the case of development consisting of the winning or working of minerals, a person entitled to an interest in a mineral in the land (other than oil, gas, coal, gold, or silver)

"Tenant" means an agricultural tenant, as defined in section 65(8) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, of land any part of which is comprised in the land to which the application relates.

Statement of owners' rights:

The grant of planning permission does not affect owners' rights to retain or dispose of their property, unless there is some provision to the contrary in an agreement or in a lease.

Statement of agricultural tenants' rights:

The grant of planning permission for non-agricultural development may affect agricultural tenants' security of tenure.
