Application by Nuon UK Ltd dated 30 November 2007 for consent to construct and operate a 59.5MW Wind Turbine Generating Station in Powys, Mid Wales ("Llanbadarn Fynydd")

In 2007, Nuon UK Ltd submitted an application under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to the Department for Energy and Climate Change together with a request for deemed planning permission under section 90 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for consent to construct and operate Llanbadarn Fynydd (the "**Application**"). The Application is the subject of a conjoined planning inquiry, running from June 2013 to May 2014.

Historically, Nuon UK Ltd (company number 03446477) traded as Nuon Renewables. Following Nuon's acquisition by Vattenfall in 2009, Nuon UK Ltd began trading as Vattenfall. This was confirmed to you in a letter from Vattenfall dated 12 March 2012, which stated "Nuon Renewables is adopting the name of its parent company, Vattenfall, one of Europe's largest and most respected energy companies." Accordingly, Vattenfall rather than Nuon Renewables has been referred to in recent correspondence with DECC and during the planning inquiry.

Notwithstanding the fact that Nuon UK Ltd trades as Vattenfall, this letter is to confirm that the legal entity making the Application was and remains Nuon UK Ltd. If consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 is granted in respect of Llanbadarn Fynydd, such consent should be granted in the name of Nuon UK Ltd. This clarification has no material effect on any of the evidence that has been submitted to the inquiry.
