**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF SUPPLEMENTARY ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION FOR  
THE PROPOSED REPOWERING AND EXTENSION OF THE WIND FARM AT LLANDINAM,  
NEAR NEWTOWN, POWYS**

CeltPower Ltd (Reg. No. 02656561) (whose registered address is 3 Prenton Way, CH43 3ET) applied under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2008 for consent for the above development, which includes decommissioning of the existing 102 turbines and their replacement with 34 new turbines and other infrastructure comprising a windfarm of up to 102 MW installed capacity. The application is to be considered at a public inquiry to commence 10am on 4 June 2013 at the Royal Oak, Welshpool.

NOTICE IS HEREBY given under regulation 14A of the above regulations that CeltPower Ltd has submitted, to the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change, Supplementary Environmental Information ("SEI") (dated April 2013) in addition to the original Environmental Statement (dated May 2008) and previous Supplementary Environmental Information (dated December 2011) submitted in support of its application.
