Further to the meeting at Llandrindodd Wells on the 29<sup>th</sup> Novemeber we wish to submit the following for consideration under 'Draft Statement of Matters'

1. Consideration should be given to the impact of the 'National Grid-Mid Wales Connection' proposal that would be necessary to connect the Wind Farms in this inquiry to the existing national grid network. This covers the collection hub (proposed at Cefn Coch, Powys), The 400kv grid line between the Hub and the existing 400kv line at Lower Frankton( Shropshire) and the Connection point at Lower Frankton.
2. The impact on the flood plain at the confluence of the River 's Severn and Vyrnwy.
3. Under item 4 of Draft Matters to include Glyndwr's Way(National Trail).

In respect to the venue for the CPI consideration should be given to the inquiry being held at Welshpool - suggestions are Welshpool Town Hall or Powys County Council Offices, Severn St. Additionally there is a good rail service and accommodation within the locality( suggestions Royal Oak(Welspool), Sweeny Hall (Oswestry) and Pen-y-Dyffrn (Oswestry) as possibilities.
