Llandrinio & Arddleen Community Council wish to respond to the above Supplementary Environmental Information in connection with the above proposed development.

The Community Council is particularly concerned about the transport implications and especially the cumulative effects when all the planning applications are taken into account. We have conducted a survey of our residents and the majority are concerned about the transport of components' along the A483 and beyond. This will have an impact on the daily lives of residents many of which may have to seek alternative routes to work to avoid the congestion. Ambulance times are under scrutiny at the moment because they exceed the guidelines – we would seek reassurance that emergency vehicles will not be delayed by these convoys. The other area for concern is the effect the transportation of components will have on the Mid-Wales economy as a whole with anticipated grid lock through Welshpool how many firms will want to re-locate to this area.
