

VAD would wish to make representation at the inquiry with respect to the following issues :

Development of the five windfarms and their associated electrical infrastructure is not commensurate with sustainable development . Such development has already been obtained with the 250 windturbines in mid-Wales.

The considerable amount of Significant effects (identified under EIA regulations) that the developers have identified in their Environmental Statements are well beyond the capacity of Mid-Wales to absorb. There are also considerably more effects that the developers argue are not Significant but, with more impartial analysis, would be so designated

The developments are not commensurate with the European Directive for renewable energy schemes to be proportionate with respect to their effects and utility.

Windfarm targets are believed to be overruling the legitimate concerns of the Mid-Wales population. We wish to demonstrate that these targets are not soundly based.

As well as the above cumulative and policy areas we would like to make short representations regarding the Significant effects of each of the six applications.
