I understand that the developer has attempted to reduce the visual impact of the Llandinam wind power station by relocating and/or repositioning a couple of the turbines.

I understand that the same developer calculated that since each turbine disappears in the crowd, the visual impact of each is "Minimum". The logic of this argument is baffling and the argument should be dismissed by the forthcoming public enquiry. There are 39 wind turbines planned for this site.
