

I Sarah Sanford of (address removed for web) will state as follows:

1. I wish to object to the wind farm application known as Llanbadarn Fynydd which is subject to the Conjoined Planning Enquiry that commenced on 4 June 2013.

2. I live at the above address and have done so for the past 13 years. I live here with my husband.

3. I wish to object to the building of this and other wind farms in the vicinity because I consider that the landscape will be ruined and my quality of life destroyed.

4. I came to live here in a deliberate effort to live in an unspoilt environment and the building of these wind farms will change that beyond recognition.

5. I have spent considerable amounts of money and time developing my house and garden so that they can be a facility for me to enjoy. I will be deprived of the benefits of these efforts by the construction of the turbines.

6. Although outside the remit of this inquiry I shall be effectively surrounded on all sides by turbines if the proposed sites at Llanbadarn Ffynydd, Garreg Lwyd Hill and Bryngydfa go ahead. The inquiry cannot dismiss the potential cumulative effect of 52 turbines.

7. I shall submit a further written statement (proofs of evidence) by 6 August. I wish to speak at the inquiry.
